

# Tissue Viability & Wound Management

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## Overview

The Wound Assessment Training course is for staff currently working within the Health Care sector. Candidates will benefit from having knowledge of wound assessment and an understanding of causes, stages, treatment and risk factors associated with a service user with a wound. The Assessment and Management of Wounds study day is aimed at all healthcare practitioners involved in wound care. It will explore contemporary issues in tissue viability including: quality indicators in tissue viability, wound assessment, and product selection. Attending the course you will use simulated wounds to aid knowledge and skill development, and gauge the impact wounds have on patient's health and well-being.

## Course content:

The following topics are covered in this course.

- Introduction to Wound Assessment, Definition of a wound and Wound Management
- Wound Assessments stages of ulcers
- Treatment of wound and Deep tissue injuries
- Define Pressure sore and its different stages, common areas, causes, symptoms and treatments
- Different Medical conditions that affect pressure sore healing
- Pressure-relieving devices and support
- How Pressure Sore can be prevented
- Risk Factors
- Healing Documents and record keeping
